Montgomery County Cancer Association (MCCA)

Financial Assistance Program Benefits

Before MCCA can provide financial assistance, the patient must provide the following documentation:

1. The person must provide a document which proves their permanent residence in Montgomery County, Illinois for the past year, i.e. year-old power bill, year-old water bill, lease, last year's real estate tax bill.
2. The person must provide a signed document, from their physician, summarizing their cancer diagnosis and treatment plan.
3. Complete the *MCCA Patient Financial Application*.

MCCA can provide the following benefits:

1. MCCA pays .65 cents per mile: round-trip to and from cancer-related doctor or treatment appointments. This is separate from any other financial assistance. This financial assistance will be paid directly to the patient. The patient is required to complete all highlighted items on the *Mileage Reimbursement Form*.
2. When a patient is first diagnosed with cancer or during their cancer treatment, MCCA will pay \$2,000 in additional financial assistance each calendar year. (Cancer treatment includes chemotherapy, radiation, any reconstruction related to the cancer diagnosis, or physician prescribed cancer treatment.) This benefit can be used for rent, mortgage, homeowners' insurance, auto insurance, health insurance, property taxes, utilities (not cable TV, telephone company, or cell phones), medical bills related to the diagnosis, and/or medications related to the diagnosis. We will not pay credit card bills. MCCA must pay the vendor directly. We will not reimburse the patient for paying these bills.
